
## **Nursing Workforce** in Australia





## CANCER NURSING WORKFORCE DEMOGRAPHICS

In 2020, the Cancer Nurses Society of Australia advocated to incorporate cancer care as a job area health professionals could nominate in their AHPRA registration. As a result, we now have 3 full years of data specific to the cancer care nursing workforce (see below).

Australian-born Aboriginal and/or **Torres Strait Islander** 




